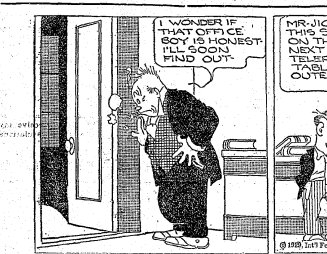

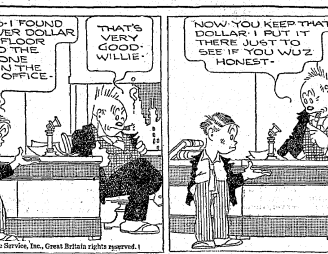

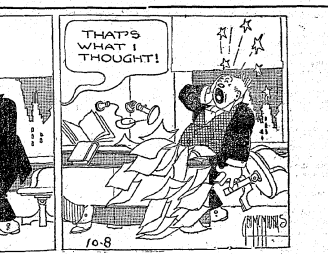

AFRICA WANTS UNION RESIDENT AS GOVERNOR

LONDON, Oct. 12.—Loud demands by the Dutch political organisms in South Africa that the next governor should be a citizen of the Union, especially for the Dutch.

LLOYD GEORGE PRAISES AND BLAMES LABOR

Likens Cabinet to Four-Months-Old Baby of Adoring Parents

LONDON, Oct. 14.—Lloyd George, winding up the Liberal Party conference in Nottingham, described the MacDonald Government as a "four-months-old baby in which the dotting parents find all sorts of beauties not so apparent to all of us."

Labor, he continued, had tried to cure this or that Liberal candidate with bribes but the supply of failed labor was running short and Labor was beginning now to ration it.

Referring to the possibility of another election, he said: "The Government think it's got the whole country behind it and will say, 'We want a majority.' They'll pick their ground. The Liberals will fight next time as a united party."

Discussing the Labor Government's record, Mr. Lloyd George said: "If you take what was done at the House, I have nothing but unqualified, unconditional praise and admiration. Sir Snowden showed courage and resolution in face of difficulties, greater difficulties than perhaps have yet revealed which did not all come from foreign powers."

In Palestine, he continued, the Government was caught napping, but he was not disposed to criticize them too severely for that reason.

Mr. Lloyd complained that in Great Britain the high commission was at the level even of the smallest European states and wants to see, as he expressed it at a banquet given last night in London, the high commission entitled to the same status as the diplomatic representative of any other country.

Lord Passfield, Dominions secretary, admitted that there was difficulty over the diplomatic standing of the Empire's representatives. "The Union of South Africa was a full international unit," but it is also, he added, "remembering that, it is an integral and full member of the British Commonwealth," so he argued, they could not have both war, or conventionally representative of the British Commonwealth of Nations on the level of strangers or foreigners in this country.
