



 Caldwell of the same place. I as such trustee have given granted, remised, released
 and forever quit claimed and do by these presents absolutely give grant remise
 release and forever quit claim unto the said Fanny F. Caldwell to her heirs &
 assigns forever all such right and title as I the said Pingham have or ought to
 have in or to the following described land situate in Cleveland township number
 seven in range twelve in the Connecticut Western Reserve in the State of Ohio in
 Cuyahoga County and is bounded as follows to wit. Beginning on the
